## **EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR INDUSTRIAL WORKPLACES COURSE**

This training is aimed at industries that need to maintain employee safety and respond to a wide range of emergency incidents that occur on site.

These industries typically use emergency control organisation teams as an effective response to emergency incidents. Onsite teams are trained to respond to incidents that threaten both human and physical resources.

### **Content**
