CHIEF WARDEN COURSE

This course is designed for people who are assigned the responsibility as the Chief Warden (and their deputies) in their workplace. The course is structured in accordance with Australian Standards: Planning for emergencies in facilities (AS 3745), Planning for Emergencies – Health Care Facilities (AS 4083) and the General Fire Regulations (where applicable).

Participants are exposed to relevant information for their role as a Chief Warden. This information supports the implementation of emergency procedures, staff training requirements and the roles and responsibilities of the Chief Warden in the event of an emergency that may warrant an evacuation. Successful participants will receive a Statement of Completion accredited by the Tasmania Fire Service. Content

- The Chief Wardens role and responsibilities
- The acts and regulations relating to the Emergency Control Organisation
- The management of the evacuation
- Responding to different emergencies
- Liaising with emergency services
- Strategies in emergency prevention management
- Communication systems
- Recovery planning

Prerequisite

There are no pre-requisites for undertaking this course. However it is recommended that participants have either previously undertaken warden training or possess a strong understanding of the role of a warden in the workplace.

Cost

The course duration is one day and the fee is \$410 (GST inclusive) per participant.
